Even though the 2011 tax year has come to a close, it's not too early to start thinking about your 2012 taxes. Family Connections can help you qualify for a great WV state tax credit while you assist us in fulfilling our mission.



We've been thrilled to provide documentation to several WV donors so they might receive a tax credit on their WV state income tax return. Businesses and individuals who contributed at least \$500 to Family Connections can file for a tax credit equal to 50% of their donation. This great "perk" is available due to our participation in the WV Neighborhood Investment Program. Our allowable credit is limited so we must offer


MISSION STATEMENT
